## **History of Okakarara VTC**

The centre officially opened in January 1977 as Okakarara Technical Institute or Okakarara Tegniese Instituut by Mr. Jan Malan. It started off with 21 trainees and offered only two trades, Carpentry and Bricklaying, including Technical Drawing.

In 1979, two more trades, Welding and Motor Mechanics were introduced. Under the able and dedicated leadership, more trades were added to the list in 1984. These include Plumbing & Pipe Fitting, Electrical General, Hairdressing, Tailoring, Hospitality & Tourism, and Office Administration. In the same year of 1984, the centre was renamed from Okakarara Technical Institute to Okakarara Vocational Training Centre (OVTC).

Over the years, OVTC has aspired to be the centre of excellence by producing a number of young Namibians who have thus far, graduated as competent youth, who are able to take up employment in their respective industry sectors, with ease.

The number of graduates from OVTC can be traced to be at +-12,000 at the moment, with 80% of these employed in different industries and 20% are self- employed.

At the moment, the centre boosts with an intake of+-1100 trainees registered, the number which we believe as a centre is ever growing

because of the positive and close relationship we maintain with inhabitants of the town and the communities surrounding us.

OVTC has a compliment of 71 staff members, of which 30 are Trainers and 37 administrative staff. The pass rate at the centre is at 70% currently. Ten trades are offered at the centre, which are all accredited by the Namibia Qualifications Authority (NQA).

Okakarara VTC continues to live up to its reputation of turning out high quality VET graduates, who are able to become future entrepreneurs.

## When and where is this is happening?
